

From I-81 South –

Take Kirkwood, Conklin exit off I-81. At the end of exit ramp turn right (sign says “to Route 7”). Cross 2 bridges. At traffic light turn left on Route 7 South. Go 1½ miles to Blinker Light. Route 7 South turns Right. Go right on Route 7 South to PA State Line. Route 7 South becomes Route 29. Continue on Route 29 South through Montrose (turning left at traffic light in center of town) to Springville. Turn right (West) at the Gas Station. Bear left at the “Y” at the end of town (State Route 3006). Go approximately 2.5 miles to Mitchell Road (the 2nd dirt road to the left) and turn left. Look for the signs about ¼ mile on the left.

From I-81 North –

Take Clarks Summit exit off I-81. Follow Routes 6 & 11 West past Keystone Junior College in Factoryville. When Routes 6 & 11 split (past the Bluebird II Diner), bear right on Route 6. Continue on Route 6 West to Tunkhannock. At the traffic light turn right on Route 29 North. Go 12 miles north to Springville. Turn left (West) at the Gas Station. Bear left at the “Y” at the end of town (State Route 3006). Go approximately 2.5 miles to Mitchell Road (the 2nd dirt road to the left) and turn left. Look for the signs about ¼ mile on the left.

From Wilkes-Barre –

Take Route 309 North to Route 29 North. Follow Route 29 straight through traffic light in Tunkhannock. Go 12 miles north to Springville. Turn left (West) at the Gas Station. Bear left at the “Y” at the end of town (State Route 3006). Go approximately 2.5 miles to Mitchell Road (the 2nd dirt road to the left) and turn left. Look for the signs about ¼ mile on the left.

From Towanda –

Take Route 220 to Route 6 East. Continue on Route 6 East through Wyalusing and Laceyville to Meshoppen. Approximately 1 mile past the blinker light in Meshoppen bear left on Kaiserville Road (the signs says “Kaiserville 3 miles”). Go left on the first paved road (Farr Road). Paved road turns dirt. Bear right at the “Y”. Go straight through the next “4-Corner” intersection. Take the first dirt road to the left (Mitchell Road). Look for the signs at the top of the hill.

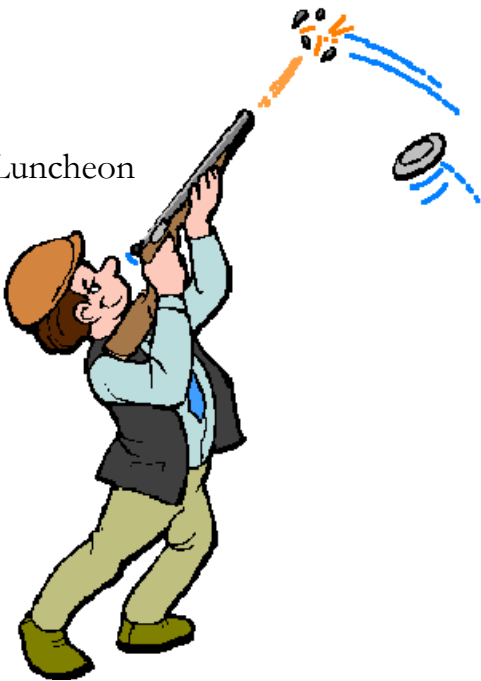

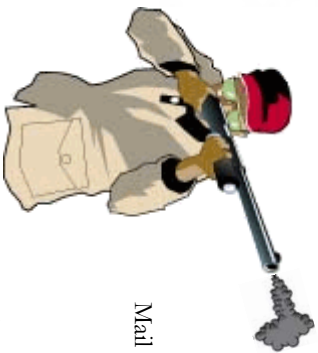
